



Spectator Parking Information

Parking is available on campus for game days. Enter campus at Entrance A. See the map below for addresses, directions to the stadium from parking, and parking areas. Ample street parking is available around the campus but read the signs carefully. The vehicle owner will be responsible for the costs if a vehicle is towed or ticketed. Due to campus construction, handicap parking is a challenge as handicap parking for the stadium is currently offline. Locker Room Policies

A locker room will be made available inside Don Shula Stadium. Upon arrival, an official from the Benedicitne will meet and escort the visiting team to their assigned locker room. John Carroll University will be responsible for locking and securing the locker room during athletic contests when the locker room is not in use. All locker rooms are cleaned, stocked, and prepared for the visiting team's arrival. These facilities will be inspected shortly after a team's departure. Any resulting damage to the facilities will be assessed to the visiting organization.

Inclement Weather Policy

In the event of an emergency, the Public Address announcer on site will give directions.

In the event of thunderstorms or lightning strikes at Don Shula Stadium, fans can seek shelter under the stadium stands in the concourse area. Alternatively, fans may choose to return to their cars for safety. Thirty-Minute Rule – Competition or practice shall be suspended once lightning has been recognized or thunder is heard. It is required to wait at least 30 minutes after the last flash of lightning is witnessed or thunder is heard before resuming practice or competition. Given the average rates of thunderstorm travel, the storm should move 10-12 miles away from the area. This significantly reduces the risk of local lightning flashes. Any subsequent lightning or thunder after the beginning of the 30-minute count shall reset the clock, and another count shall begin.

NFHS Policy

At night, under certain atmospheric conditions, lightning flashes from distant storms may be visible. In such cases, it may be safe to continue the event if no thunder is heard and the flashes are low on the horizon, indicating the storm is far away and may not pose a threat. Using independently verified lightning detection information can help eliminate any uncertainty.
